

Cancellation and modification conditions

Cancellation at the attendee's initiative

- Until 24th October: refund of 100% of the fee paid.
- Until 30th October 2025: refund of 50% of the fee paid.
- From 11 November: no refund.

Modification of the attendee details

No refund will be available in case of a no-show.

Cancellation at the organizers' initiative

Modification of the programme

The organizers reserve the right to modify the event program at any time, which is published as an indication only and subject to change.

No waiving of fees nor right to further claims will be possible should the organizers be obliged to alter the program of ICODSIP 2025.

Changes, postponement and cancellation

Given force majeure, the organizers are entitled to postpone (modify the dates), to curtail the duration, or to cancel the onsite event. In the event of complete or part postponement or curtailment, the registration is regarded as valid for a possible new date and new duration for the said onsite event.

If the onsite event has to be canceled, the organizers will strive to maintain the online event and any onsite registration will be automatically transferred to an online registration. The attendee will be refunded 70% of the fee originally paid.

If, due to any contingency that the organizers cannot overcome (in particular force majeure), both the onsite event and the online event have to be canceled, registrations by individuals will be reimbursed in full.

Apart from reimbursement of registration fees, assistants will not be entitled to compensation for any costs or damages incurred as a consequence of such event cancellation, change or postponement.

The organizers will not be liable for any theft or damage to property and/or persons caused on site during the event, by any factor whatsoever, unless there has been a fault, intent or deliberate recklessness on the part of organizers.
